
RESERVE SUPER PASO

Bootjack Ranch, Paso Robles 50% Petit Verdot · 33% Barbera · 15%Cabernet Sauvignon 2% Sangiovese



VINEYARD

The fantastic weather of 2018 resulted in a near perfect growing season at Bootjack Ranch. The mild weather allowed us to harvest each block of grapes leisurely and intentionally. The Petit Verdot in particular showed fantastic color and flavor development that made it a stand out. As soon as we harvested it, we knew it would become the focus of the vintage's Super Paso.

WINEMAKING

The name "Super Paso" is inspired by Super Tuscans – blends made by Italian winemakers who took an unconventional path and added French grape varietals to their Sangiovese. As an ode to those renegade winemakers, we add non-Italian varietals to our Sangiovese and Barbera for additional complexity. The Petit Verdot, which made up half of the blend, had robust color, beautiful fruit flavors and exceptionally wellbalanced tannins. Barbera's plush and approachable profile made it a great counterbalance to the dark Petit Verdot. All four grape varietals were harvested and fermented individually in stainless steel tanks. The blend was composed shortly after harvest and aged together for 17 months in 40% new French Oak barrels. Aging Recommendation: Early Maturity -Drink now or hold for additional aging. Reviewed January 2021.
